Larson presented a short Powerpoint Presentation giving the audience a brief introduction to the project, the grant, the purpose, budget, and schedule. Copy of the Presentation is attached.

Larson distributed two informational flyers, one prepared by the US EPA, the other by the Consultant, Malcolm Pirnie. See Attached.

Q: Will there be any opportunity to recycle materials in the building, such as wire, electrical switch gears, door frames, windows, concrete block/brick?

A: Larson stated that sustainable and green demolition is a high priority for the US EPA. During the preparation of the Alternatives for Brownfield Cleanup Analysis (ABCA), the Consultant will evaluate recycling opportunities.

Q: Will the materials be disposed of in the local landfill?

A: Larson noted that the Double Culvert Landfill, the local landfill, did allow regular Construction Debris (CDD) materials and any materials deemed non-hazardous that can be disposed of there will be. Otherwise, a landfill able to accept contaminated substances will be used.
