The Division of Waste Management, Superfund Branch has reevaluated the data submitted (March 27, 2006) by Air, Soil, and Water Environmental Consulting on behalf of the City of Georgetown Kentucky. The data was evaluated using the methods outlined in 401 KAR 100:030, which can be found on the Voluntary Cleanup Program Website at:

Based on this evaluation it has been determined that the metal levels in the soil do not present an unacceptable risk under Kentucky Revised Statute (KRS) 224.01-400 (18) (a) and 401 Kentucky Administrative Regulations (KAR) 100:030. Therefore, the Division's letter of June 13th, 2006 was in error. The subject site is considered to be a non-incident and no further action is necessary.

Please be advised that the above cited closure directive applies only to this specific release. The Division reserves the right to require further remedial action or corrective measures should they be warranted by additional information or a different release.
